GRANT PROJECT BUDGET ORDINANCE AMENDMENT 26-295
NC LAND AND WATER FUND (NCLWF)
OLD FIELD SWAMP SEDIMENT CONTROL PILOT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Fairmont, previously approved Ordinance 25-277 Project Budget Ordinance for the Town of Fairmont NCLWF Old Field Swamp Sediment Control Pilot Project; and

WHEREAS, it is sometimes necessary to make amendments to the project budget to reflect changes in revenues and expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Fairmont Town Council that, pursuant to Section 13.2 of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the following grant project ordinance is hereby adopted:

Section 1: This ordinance is to establish a budget for a project to be funded by NC Land and Water Fund (NCLWF) in the amount of \$58,600.

Section 2. The officers of this unit are hereby directed to proceed with the grant project within the terms of the grant documents, the rules and regulations of the NCLWF and the budget contained herein.

Section 3. The following revenues are anticipated to be available to complete this project:

NCLWF	\$57,000
Fairmont matching funds	<u>\$ 1,600</u>
TOTAL	\$58,600

Section 4. The following amounts are appropriated for the project and authorized for expenditure:

Design and Permitting	\$57,000
Project Administration	<u>\$ 1,600</u>
TOTAL	\$58,600

Section 5: The Finance Officer is hereby directed to maintain sufficient specific detailed accounting records to satisfy the requirements of the grantor agency and the grant agreements.

Section 6: The Finance Officer is hereby directed to report the financial status of the project to the governing board on a monthly basis.

Section 7: Copies of this grant project ordinance shall be furnished to the Budget Officer, the Finance Officer and to the Clerk to Town Council.

Section 8: This grant project ordinance expires on July 31, 2028, or when all the NCLWF grant funds have been obligated and expended by the town, whichever occurs sooner.
